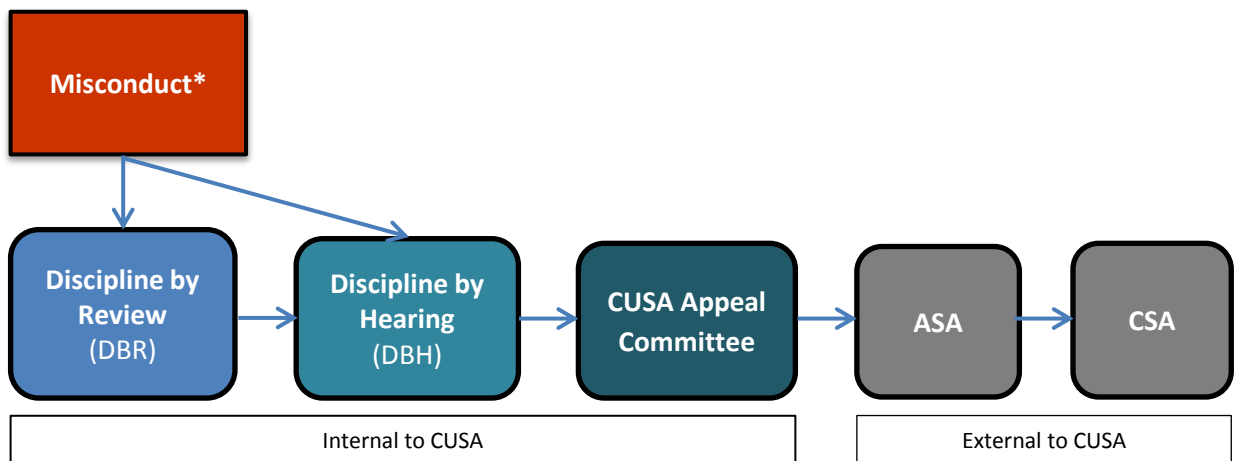


DISCIPLINARY PROCESS

- A revised process for the handling of alleged misconduct has now been implemented.
- Misconduct that appears to fall within certain Discipline Code sections will be adjudicated by a CUSA administrator (Discipline by Review, DBR) while misconduct falling into other Code sections must be adjudicated by a Discipline Committee (Discipline by Hearing, DBH).

Disciplinary Process Flowchart (including appeals)



Misconduct as defined by the CUSA Discipline Code sections below will be adjudicated as follows:

Discipline by Review (DBR)*	Discipline by Hearing (DBH)
A(1-5)- OIAL at official	A(6)- threats to officials
B –I- 2 nd cautions, to pushing, to striking, to head butting	J, K- uncontrollable rage, spitting; player disguises identity, leaving the playing area to fight with fans
L, M, O(1-17, 19)- ineligible guest players; game forfeitures such as too few players, no ID cards	N, O(18)- racial slurs; game abandonment
P, R, T – W- no alternate uniform, false info. on registration form, 3 on-field forfeitures, no-show for hearings, not attending AGM	Q, S- spectator interference; bringing the game into disrepute

- Any outcome provided via the DBR process will only consider the content of the Misconduct Report; however, the outcome can be challenged by having a hearing with the CUSA Discipline Committee.
- Additionally, any alleged misconduct received by CUSA can be forwarded directly to the Discipline Committee at the discretion of the administrator.
